### **Overall Objective:**

To develop a social volunteering project with the women community "Sobrevivientes Victoriosas" and Tecnológico de Antioquia's students (Medellín - Colombia ) for training in English and entrepreneurship abilities through joint and collaborative work

#### **Description:**

Volunteering TdeA: Working Together with the Community is a project to encourage the support of academy and its knowledge to Medellin vulnerable communities, specially the women community "Sobrevivientes Victoriosas". Through collaborative work between American and Colombian students, it will allow women to develop English language skills and develop entrepreneurial abilities, in a virtual learning setting.

This project will also build an intercultural exchange environment for Colombian and American students to improve and practice their language skills, get closer knowledge of each other's culture and foster binational relations. The project aims at the strengthening of transversal and social competences that will allow students to understand their role in local communities and complement their professional profile. The volunteering activities are divided into two goals: English teaching and entrepreneurial improvement of *"Sobrevivientes Victoriosas"* community, enhancing their role as active and productive members of the post-conflict society.





### Benefits:

- Selected students will receive preparatory training in intercultural skills and social intervention, in a 48-hour virtual course, between synchronous and asynchronous activities
- Global training and experience will enable students to put their knowledge into practice, acquire global competencies and become active agents on the global development agenda.
- American students will receive a Spanish course as an activity to enhance their international profile (40 hours).
- Certificate of participation and fulfillment of Volunteering TdeA learning outcomes
- Participation on intercultural events
- Virtual tours in Medellín city
- Participation in Spanish conversational groups (Meet Up Sessions) with Colombian students
- Participation is free, volunteer student should sign a letter of commitment

- 7. Recommendation letter by any faculty member at your home institution
- 8. Statement of purpose.
